



# BIKE & RUN

A new kind of race has made its debut and JPL is helping to introduce it to Southern California. BIKE & RUN resembles a relay race in that the cyclist goes on ahead of the runner, then leaves the bike and continues on foot. When the runner reaches the bike, he jumps on and rides until he builds a lead, then he puts the bike down and starts running again. And on and on. This is a race where strategy may win over brawn.

The race is approximately 9 miles along a course that leave the JPL Visitor Parking Lot, goes along residential streets to the Rose Bowl, and then back to JPL again. Sounds easy, right? -- Did I mention that the return route is almost all uphill?

Advance entry fee of \$7 per person covers a Bike & Run cyclist cap, a continental breakfast catered by PARTYLINE, Inc., rider numbers, and ribbons for the winning teams. (Fee is \$9 per person on day of ride.) Mail entry deadline is MONDAY, JUNE 2. (See reverse side of this flyer for map to JPL.)

The race will start at 7:00 A.M. SHARP. Sign-in begins at 6:15 A.M. A release form and a course map will be provided at that time. Parent/guardian signature required for participants under 18 years of age.

**DON'T HAVE A TEAMMATE?** Unpaired entrants will be matched up (luck of the draw) on June 2 for preregistered entries, and at 6:30 A.M. on day of ride for late registrants.

Ribbons will be presented to the first placed Men's, Women's, and Mixed teams.

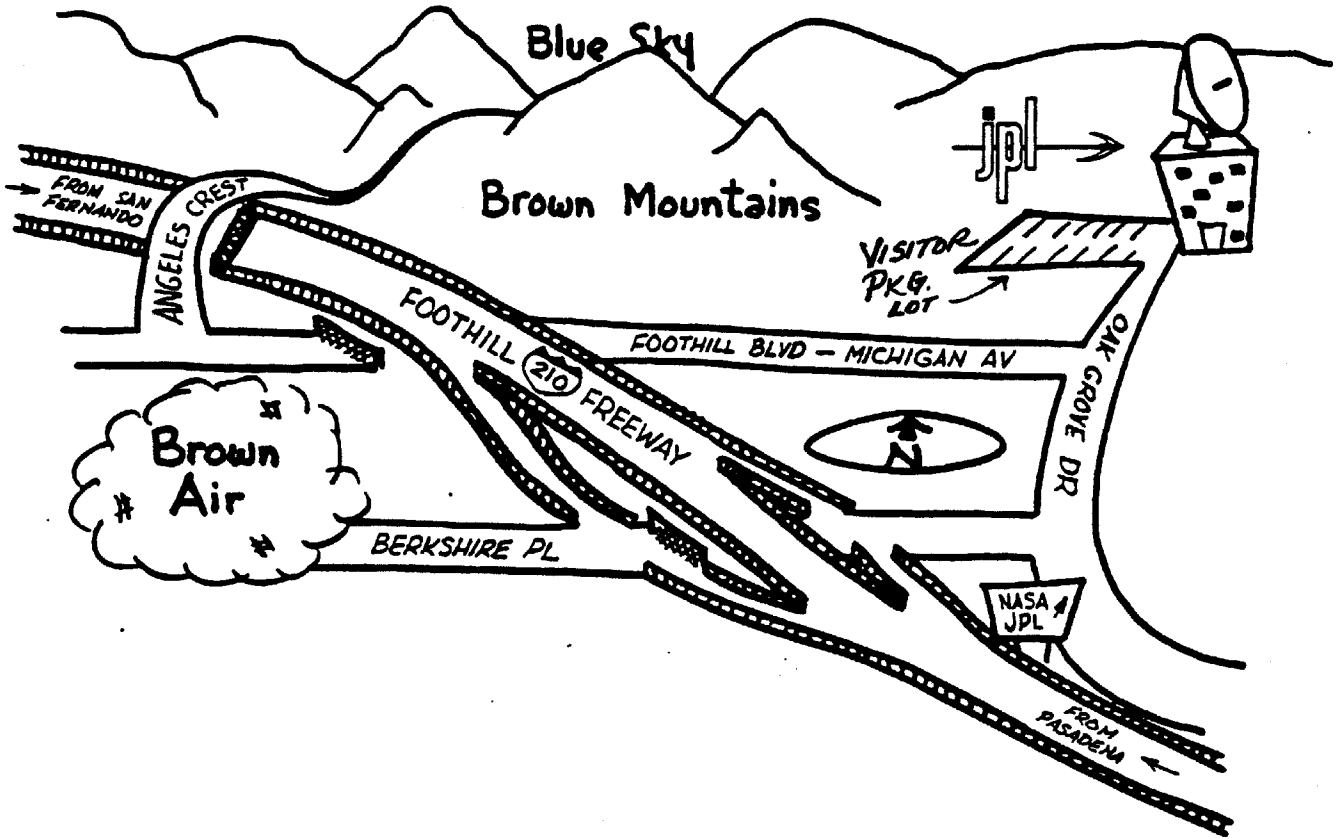
